

New Handicapping Rules for Heys Trophy

The proposed new handicapping system for the Heys Trophy is as follows:

Each team will consist of 8 registrations each registration having a individual handicap from the team they represent in the appropriate leagues they play in.

Handicaps for players registered in more than one league will be added together & halved & that will be the handicap for the players for the duration that they are in the tournament.

For Example

Player 1 Hcp 10, Player 2 Hcp 20, Player 3 Hcp -10, Player 4 Hcp 25, Player 5 Hcp 30,
Player 6 Hcp 18, Player 7 Hcp 6, Player 8 Hcp 25.

Leg 1 Team

Player 1 Hcp 10, Player 3 Hcp -10, Player 6 Hcp 18, Player 8 Hcp 25 team Handicap Leg 1 is 43 double that to get 86 because you are playing 2 frames each on the night & that is your handicap for the 1st leg.

Leg 2 Team

Player 1 Hcp 10, Player 4 Hcp 25, Player 6 Hcp 18, Player 8 Hcp 25 team Handicap Leg 2 is 78 double that to get 156 because you are playing 2 frames each on the night & that is your handicap for the 2nd leg.

This way rather than the team having a Handicap that you are penalised for when your -10 man cannot play in the 2nd leg, you can just bring in another registered player & your handicap will be adjusted according to who you bring in.
